Crimson Pygmy Barberry	S	Berberis thunbergii	2' x 2'	Low growing shrub with shiny wine-red leaves, could be used as a hedge
Bluemist Spirea	S X	Caryopteris clandonesis	3' x 4'	Shrub with blue flowers in late summer, attracts bees
Verigated Dogwood	S PS	Cornus alba 'Bailhalo'	8' x 5'	Deciduous Shrub. Hardy
Kelsey Dogwood	PS	Cornus sericea 'Kelseyi'	2' x 2'	Compact, hardy Dark green foliage to red in the fall
Euonymous	PS S	Euonymus alatus	2'-3' x 4'-5'	Different varieties such as 'Emerald Gaiety', 'Emerald 'N Gold', and 'Winter Creeper' are permitted
Gold Drop Potentilla	S	Potentilla fruitcosa	2' x 3' +	Bright green foliage with lemon yellow flowers through summer
Native Potentilla	W N	Potentilla fruitcosa	2' x 3' +	Green foliage with yellow flowers all summer
Purple Leaf Sand Cherry	PS S	Prunus cistena	4' x 3'	Purple foliage
Grow-low Sumac	X	Rhus aromatica	18-24" x 4'	Low spreading habit with glossy green foliage and reddish fall color.
Spirea	S	Spiraea bumalda	2' x 4'	Smaller green-leafed varieties such as 'Forebel', 'Anthony Waterer', 'Lime Mound', 'Gold Flame' and 'Little Princess are permitted.
Daphine Spirea		Spiraea japonica 'Alpina'	1' x 2'	Dense, mounded shrub with clusters of rich rose-pink flowers in summer
Dwarf Korean Lilac	S	Syringa meyeri	4' x 3'	Early bloomer with lilac flowers, fragrant
Dwarf European Cranberry	PS S	Viburnum opulus	2' x 2'	Compact, hardy, red berries in the fall

Dwarf Bird's Nest Spruce	S PS	Picea abies	2 -3' x 4-5'	Spreading nest-like mound of grayish green needles
Dwarf Globe Spruce	S PS	Picea pungens	3-5' x 5-6'	Compact, rounded, blue color. Slow grower, densely branched.
Mugo Pine	S	Pinus mugo	4' x 5'	Mushroom-shaped, hardy and rugged
Mops Mugo	S	Pinus mugo	5' x 6'	Compact, hardy, slow-growing
Slowmound Mugo Pine	S	Pinus mugo	2' x 3'	Dense dark green needles and says round and compact

Elijah Blue Fescue	S	Festuca glauca	8-12" x 8-12"	Small, vivid blue color
Blood Grass	PS S	Imperata cylindrica	1-1.5' x 2-3'	Red Tips, low-growing, spreads
Morning light Miscanthus	S	Miscanthus sinensis	4-5' x 2-3'	Hardy, Fine textured leaves
Purple Fountain Grass	S	Rubrum	24-36" x	Purple foliage with feather-like plumes at the end
Blue Avena	PS S	Helictotrichon sempervirens	2-3' x 2-3'	Medium-sized, great blue color

Yarrow	S X	Achillea spp.		Very tough. Full sun. Spreads, so plant sparingly. Varieties such as 'Double Bubblemint' and 'Sunset' are permitted. Good in dry-land transitions. Hummingbird friendly.
Hyssop - Varieties	S X	Agastache	16-18" x 12-16"	Shaded Woodland sites preferred.
Columbine - Varieties	Sh N	Aquilegia spp.	28-32" x 16-18"	Likes poor, sandy soil.
Butterfly Weed	S N X	Asclepia tuberosa	12-36" x 24"	Masses of chalice shaped magenta flowers on trailing, deeply lobed foliage. Excellent as a rock garden plant or ground cover. Blooms early summer
Poppy Mallow (Winecups)	S N X	Callirhoe involucrata	6-8" x 24-30"	Blooms July-Sept. Tends to re-seed itself. Definitely prone to re-seeding, so great for larger swaths of color, not good if you want it contained.
Harebell/Bell Flower	PS Sh	Campanula ssp	12-18" x 12"	Gray foliage, white flowers, blooms early summer
Jupiter's Beard	S X	Centranthus rubur	2' x 1.5'	Drought-tolerant, long blooming season. Blooms vary from yellow, pink, reds and variegated.
Snow-In-Summer	X	Cerastium tomentosum	6" x 1'	Slow creeper, usually keeps round shape
Tickseed - Varieties	S	Coreopsis	15" x 12"	
Ice Plant - Varieties	X	Delosperma		
Dianthus - Varieties	N X	Dianthus	3-8" x 8-12"	Varities such as 'First Love', 'Zing Rose', 'Tiny Rubies', and 'Cottage Pinks' are permitted.

Bleeding Hearts	PS Sh W	Dicentra	18-24" x 24"	Varieties such as 'Gold Heart', 'King of Hearts', and 'Amore Rose' are permitted. Heart-shaped blooms on an arching stem bloom in the Spring. Herbacious Perennial which needs moisture.
Coneflower - Varieties	S N X	Echinacea	2.5-3' x 2'	Varieties such as 'Magnus' are permitted. Attracts butterflies. Blooms June-Sept. Herbacious perennial. Foliage comes in all shades and verigation. The darker the color the more shade is required. Blooms from July to Sept.
Hosta - Varieties	PS Sh	Funkia	8-12" x 1-1.5'	
Sweet Woodruff	PS Sh W	Galium odoratum		Great planted under evergreens as ground cover. Herbacious perennial, needs moisture. Varieties such as 'Stella d'oro', Yellow or Orange are permitted. Accent only, shouldn't be planted in masses
Daylilies - Varieties	S X	Hemerocallis ssp.		Ruffled green foliage, spindly pink blooms May-June Xeric when planted in the shade. Requires dead-heading
Sandia Coral Bells	PS Sh	Heuchera pulchella	4-6" x 6-10"	Green foliage, spindly red blooms Spring-Early summer Excellent for dry shade. Requires dead-heading.
Snow Angel Coral Bells	PS Sh	Heuchera sanguinea	6-14" x 8-12"	Varieties such as are permitted.
Iris - Varieties	N X			Varieties such as 'Fire Dance - Dwarf', 'Echo Rojo', 'Regal' are permitted. Hummingbird and butterfly friendly. Rabbit resistant. Drought tolerant.
Torch Lily - Red Hot Poker	S PS X	Kniphofia	24-36" x 24"	
Dead Nettles	PS Sh	Lamium	6-8" x 12"	Varieties such as 'Purple Dragon', 'Orchid Frost', and 'Pink Pewter' are permitted. Excellent, slow-growing ground cover in shady areas. Blooms late spring-early summer.

Rose Mallow		Lavatera trimestris	3-6' x 3-6'	Herbacious perennial, shrubby plant with rich, green foliage and 4" blooms that appear from midsummer until frost. The satiny, hibiscus-like blooms range in color from pale pink to deep rose. Attracts butterflies.
Lavendar	S X	Lavendula Angustifolia		Foliage ranges from silver to green, puple flowers, fragrant Dramatic flower spikes, attracts hummingbirds, prefers cool, evenly moist soil, needs dead-heading. Toxic.
Lupine	PS Sh	Lupinus ssp	18-24" x 24"	
Hop Flower Oregano	S X	Origanum libanoticum	10-14" x 18-24"	Vigorous, trailing herb with hop-like bracts of lavender and chartreuse through the summer months. Perfect for rock walls. Flowers summer to fall. Needs well-drained soil.
Penstemon/Beardtongue	S X	Penstamon ssp.		Varities such as 'Rocky Mountain', 'Dark Towers Hybrid', 'Carillo Red' are permitted. This thrives in most any well-drained soil with full sun exposure. Xeric. Attracts hummingbirds and bees. Rabbit resistant.
Snowmass Phlox	S PS	Phlox bifida	4-8" x 14-18"	Dark evergreen mats of 2" leaves completely covered with drift of white snowflake-like flowers in spring. Blooms April-June. Needs good drainage.
Creeping Phlox	PS Sh	Phlox subulata	4-6" x 12-18"	Mounds of color in spring.
Phlox - Varieties	S PS	Phlox paniculata	24-36" x 24"	Showy, fragrant on tall plants which bloom in July and August. Great for backgrounds and borders

Black-Eyed Susan - Varieties	S PS	Rudbeckia	30-36" x 18-24"	Varieties such as 'Goldsturm', 'Denver Daisies', and 'Indian Summer' are permitted. Blooms late summer into fall. Attracts butterflies and bees.
Salvia - Varieties	S PS X	Salvia ssp.	24-30" x 24"	Varieties such as "Caradonna" or are permitted. Blooms summer to fall. If Deadheaded can bloom a 2nd time in the season. Attracts bees. White, purple or blue blooms. Attracts butterflies. Annual versions are available, so be sure to get the perennial plant. Deadheading is necessary.
Pincushion Flower	X	Scabiosa caucasica		Varieties such as 'Autumn Joy', 'Autumn Charm', and 'Elsie's Gold' are permitted. Blooms late summer to fall.
Stonecrop	S	Sedum ssp.	18" x 18"	
Woolly Thyme	S PS	Thymus lanuginosus	1" x 24"	Superb low care groundcover thyme with fuzzy gray foliage and vigorous spreading stems that root as they spread across the soil. It rarely flowers. An ideal crack filler between flagstone and pavers. Rabbit resistant.
Tulips- Varieties	PS	Tulipa ssp.		Spring bulbs. Hardy in snow. Rabbits like to eat tender buds and leaves.
Verbena	S X	Verbena officinalis	12-30" x 16-20"	Natural vigor and abundant summer blooms. Annual versions are available, so be sure to get the perennial plant that can be hardy in zone 5.
Veronica/Speedwell	S PS	Veronica longifolia	12-18" x 24"	Varieties come in white, pink and lavender blooms. Long-lasting striking flower spikes rise above bushy foliage. Prefers consistent soil moisture. Attracts bees and butterflies.
