ROOF REPLACEMENT GUIDELINES

Revised: September 24, 2012

Written approval from the Architectural Control Committee (ACC) IS NOT required for replacement of roofing on the townhomes, provided the following materials are used for replacement.

Any townhome with wood-shake shingles (shake shingles are not permitted to be reinstalled) may use either of the following materials for replacement:

Manufacturer: CertainTeed®
Type/style: Carriage House
Color: BrownStone

Manufacturer: CertainTeed®

Type/style: Highland Slate Impact Resistant-4 (IR4)

Color: Tudor Brown

The following townhomes that currently have the CartainTeed, Carriage House, color BrownStone shingles may replace with the same or use the CertainTeed, Highland Slate Impact Resistant – 4 (IR4), color Tudor Brown shingles.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

For townhomes that share the rear section of the roof with other units, the City of Littleton Building Department requires a special metal flashing installed as a divider between the units. Contact the building department at 303-795-3751 for this requirement and to obtain the required building permit for roof replacement.
